Alessandro and Simona joined the business in 1998, when the Boston Bluestone name was born. “Whether it’s natural stone, engineered quartz materials — or anything in between — Boston Bluestone has the experience, know-how and capabilities to satisfy our diverse clients’ needs.”

The company also performs top-notch repolishing, resealing and restoration services.

As an example of its remarkable capabilities, Boston Bluestone's Restoration Division completed extensive stone refinishing work for the St. Cecelia's Church project in Boston, an Adams + Beasley undertaking.

"It was very intricate and detailed work, but that is part of our specialty," Alessandro

says. "We were extremely appreciative of how impressed Eric Adams and Angus Beasley were with our work."

Boston Bluestone owns a long history of widely known projects, dating back to downtown Boston's 99 High Street, of which Alessandro's father was an integral part. Other completed projects in the portfolio include all of the dimensional fabrication

work for floors, walls and wrapped columns on a lobby project for Allegheny Flooring, as well as a Ritz-Carlton penthouse unit project in downtown Boston.

"We've done many lobby and foyer projects around town," Alessandro says. "For the Ritz-Carlton job, we cut and installed the flooring for the foyer in the unit. We did the windowsills in granite with special details to accommodate

under-stone lighting to create the glow under the windowsills the client desired. We also did raised bars, vanity tops and full backsplashes for the unit.”

One of the company's more challenging efforts was presented on an outdoor white glass barbecue for the owners of Elizabeth Grady.

“Note everyone in this business has the ability to cut and install this particular type of glass, which requires certification,” Alessandro says.
